Primary Sector

This refers to the **economic sector** that involves extracting or harvesting **natural resources**. It includes:

- **Agriculture**
- **Fishing**
- **Forestry**
- **Mining**

So, it's about **economic activities**, not necessarily locations or landscapes.

2. Agrarian Space

This term usually refers to **landscapes or territories dominated by agricultural production**. It focuses on how **land is used for farming**, and often includes: Definición: Concepto más amplio que incluye no solo la tierra física, sino también las relaciones sociales, culturales, políticas y económicas vinculadas a la vida rural y al uso del suelo.

- **Cropland**

- Infrastructure related to farming

It emphasizes the **human-environment interaction** in farming contexts.

3. Agricultural Space

Very similar to agrarian space, but often used more narrowly to mean the **actual area used for agriculture**. Definición: Áreas físicas utilizadas específicamente para la producción agrícola, como el cultivo de plantas y la cría de animales

It might refer to:

- Fields
- Orchards
- Farmlands

In many contexts, it's used **interchangeably** with “agrarian space,” but sometimes “agrarian” carries broader social or cultural meanings.

4. Rural Space

This is the **broadest term**. It includes:

- **Agricultural/agrarian spaces**
- **Natural areas** (forests, rivers)
- **Small towns and villages**
- **Non-agricultural rural activities** (like tourism, cottage industries, etc.)

Physical Factor	Positive Influence	Negative Influence
Soil	- Fertile and deep soil	- Poor, eroded, or shallow soil
Climate	- Mild temperatures - Regular rainfall	- Droughts - Floods - Extreme temperatures
Relief/Topography	- Flat terrain allows for mechanization and easier cultivation	- Steep slopes make farming difficult
Water Resources	- Availability of water (rivers, aquifers, rainfall)	- Water scarcity - Water salinity issues
Seasonality	- Long growing season	- Short growing season
Biodiversity	- Natural vegetation protects the soil and supports ecosystems	- Pests and diseases may spread more easily
